### RESIDENTIAL TRASH & RECYCLING SCHEDULE

**SUNDAY** TRASH OUT AFTER 5 PM

**MONDAY TRASH** COLLECTION BY 7 AM

**TUESDAY TRASH OUT** AFTER 5 PM

WEDNESDAY **TRASH** COLLECTION BY 7 AM

**THURSDAY TRASH &** RECYCLING OUT AFTER 5

**FRIDAY** TRASH & **RECYCLING** BY 7 AM

**SATURDAY NO TRASH** BAGS ON THE STREET !!!

MONDAY, WEDNESDAY & FRIDAY: Collection days, place trash out no later than 7:00AM.

SUNDAY, TUESDAY & THURSDAY: Night before collection. place trash out AFTER 5:00PM.

**RECYCLING:** FRIDAY ONLY by 7:00AM. Combine in CLEAR two-ply bags or covered wheeled containers: newspapers, magazines, brown bags, white/colored paper, telephone books, junk mail, flattened cereal boxes & milk cartons, cleaned plastic, glass and cans.

**STARVE THE RATS!** Keeping trash bags off the streets until 7:00AM on collection days reduces the opportunity for rats to feed. TRASH BAGS ATTRACT RATS!!

#### TRASH BAGS & CONTAINERS:

Two-ply (black) bags or covered containers w/ tight-fitting lids.

- NO kitchen trash bags. NO CVS bags. NO open bags or containers.
- · All bags must be securely tied and containers tightly covered.

**APPLIANCE PICK-UP** by appointment only.

#### **AVOID VIOLATIONS & FINES:**

**NO** household or commercial trash in City barrels. Violations carry fines up to \$1000 per day.

The City **does not** collect building construction materials.

**DO NOT** dispose of trash anywhere other than YOUR property.

# STREET SWEEPING PROGRAM - MARCH 1 to DECEMBER 31. No posted sweeping Jan. & Feb.

- Signs are posted with days & times for each street. Avoid a \$40 ticket and \$110 tow.
- Sign up for email TOW ALERT. Go to www.cityofboston.gov/publicworks/sweeping
- Cars may return to parking after the sweeper has passed.

## DAILY CLEANLINESS

- Residents and merchants are responsible for SWEEPING the SIDEWALKS and GUTTERS in front of their property.
- Restaurant barrels and residential barrels must have tight-fitting lids and be CLOSED AT ALL TIMES.
- Dog owners are responsible for picking up after their pets and disposing of it properly. No dog waste in the sewers! **DOG WASTE ATTRACTS RATS!!**

## SNOW REMOVAL & ALERTS

- Property owners must ensure that the sidewalk area in front of their property is kept clear of snow and ice.
- Register for email KNOWSNOW program for Snow Emergency alerts. Go to www.cityofboston.gov/alerts
